#### SPECIAL NOTE: Installation Sequences

After TMS and Safety mandated preparatory steps have been taken, the installation sequence is the suggested method for completing the accessory installation. In some instances the suggested sequence is written for one associate to install and in others the sequence is given as part of a team accessory installation. Unless otherwise stated in the document, the associates may perform the installation steps in any order to make the installation as efficient as possible while maintaining consistent quality.

#### Procedure

Care must be taken when installing this accessory to ensure damage does not occur to the vehicle. The installation of this accessory should follow approved guidelines to ensure a quality installation.

These guidelines can be found in the "Accessory Installation Practices" document.

This document covers such items as:

- Vehicle Protection (use of covers and blankets, cleaning chemicals, etc.).
- Safety (eye protection, re-checking torque procedure, etc.).
- Vehicle Disassembly/Reassembly (panel removal, part storage, etc.).
- Electrical Component Disassembly/Reassembly (battery disconnection, connector removal, etc.).

### **Vehicle Preparation**

Note: The room, parts & vehicle temperature must be between 60 & 90 degree F for optimum installation.


1. Clean area of application – recessed TACOMA area in Tailgate – with 50/50 alcohol-water solution. Dry Application area with a clean lint-free wipe. Discard the wipe after a single use. Fig. 1



1. Remove clear protective cover on top of letters. Fig. 2

- 3. Remove letters without touching adhesive on back; remove one letter at a time. Fig. 5.
- 4. Install each letter by lining up edge & centering in opening of stamped area in tailgate. Fig. 6. After checking to insure the letter is centered & level, press firmly to insure adhesion.


SPECIAL NOTE: PAY SPECIAL ATTENTION TO THIN STROKES OF THE LETTER "C" TO KEEP THEM STRAIGHT. FIG. 7

5. After all letters have been applied, placed a clean cloth over the letters & gently roll with a 2" rubber roller.

6. The TACOMA logo has been successfully applied. Fig. 8

### **Audit Criteria**

- 1. Vehicle to Graphic Compatibility:
  - 1.1 Vehicle must have the appropriate Tacoma Tailgate Logo.
- 2. Cleanliness Under Graphic Surface:
  - 2.1 Surface under & around the around the graphic application area must be clean & free of foreign materials.
- 3. Alignment:
  - 3.1 Tacoma Tailgate Logo must maintain consistency in placement & alignment on unit.
- 4. Uniform & Consistent Adhesion:
  - 4.1 All letters, especially corners, must be completely & evenly adhered to vehicle surface. No edges lifting are allowed.
